

Beecroft Road bus ramp removal commencing Friday 10 February 2012

Delays are expected on the Hills M2 Motorway while removal of the Beecroft Road bus ramp is completed.

The work to remove the ramp will be undertaken over three consecutive weekends from **8pm on Friday to 5am on Monday**:

- **Friday 10 February to Monday 13 February**
- **Friday 17 February to Monday 20 February**
- **Friday 24 February to Monday 27 February**
- **Wet weather contingency – Friday 2 March to Monday 5 March**

During this work, traffic will be diverted to the opposite carriageway with **one lane remaining open in each direction**. In addition, the following ramps will be closed:

- Westbound Beecroft Road off ramp will be closed from **8pm Friday 10 February to 5am Monday 13 February** only.
- Citybound Pennant Hills Road and Beecroft Road on ramps will be closed, as required, between **8am and 7pm Saturdays and Sundays on all three weekends**.
- Westbound Herring Road and Lane Cove Road on ramps will be closed, as required, between **8am and 7pm Saturdays and Sundays on all three weekends**.

Other motorway upgrade work will be ongoing during these periods, including work at Devlins Creek Bridge, Norfolk Tunnel and west of the Terrys Creek Bridge.

Removal of the bus ramp will allow an additional lane in each direction to be constructed at this location. On completion of the upgrade, the speed limit will be reinstated to 100km/h between Lane Cove and Windsor roads, including in the Norfolk Tunnel.
