Dear resident,

Re: Changes to noise wall on the M2 near Busaco Road Bridge, Marsfield

The Hills M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway generally between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and will deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. The project aims to provide efficient and integrated transport for the community of Sydney's North-West.

Major work on the M2 Upgrade started in January 2011 and is expected to take approximately two years to complete.

To allow for widening of the motorway, an existing noise wall in the vicinity of Busaco Road Bridge on the eastbound carriageway will be relocated. A temporary noise wall will be built prior to the existing noise wall being relocated. This work is programmed as follows:

Build temporary noise wall

A temporary noise wall will be progressively constructed in sections for a length of approximately 200m in the vicinity of Busaco Road Bridge on the eastbound carriageway of the motorway.

Installation of a temporary noise wall commenced in mid March and will take approximately 5-7 weeks to complete.

The temporary noise wall will be located on the motorway side of the existing noise wall.

The temporary noise wall will be approximately 3.3m high and will be of timber construction.

Remove existing noise wall

Once the temporary noise wall is constructed, the existing noise wall will be progressively removed in sections to allow for widening work to take place.

It is anticipated that the progressive removal of the existing noise wall will commence in early April 2011.

Build new permanent noise wall

Construction of the new permanent noise wall will commence around November 2011.

The new permanent noise wall will be made of similar materials, the same height as the existing noise wall, 1.8m.

Work on the noise walls will be undertaken during standard construction hours, Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.

At times, night works will be required at this site when traffic volumes on the motorway are lower and to help ensure the safety of motorists and workers. A separate notification will be provided to

potentially affected residents with dates and details at least seven days prior to the start of any night work.


