Traffic management - Night work notification: January 2011

Dear Resident,

The M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and will deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. The project aims to provide efficient and integrated transport for the North-West Sydney community. Major work is expected to commence in early 2011 and will take approximately two years to complete.

The M2 Motorway is an important part of the overall Sydney road and transport network. This means that the motorway must still operate during construction. This requires some traffic management works to be completed outside of normal construction hours, as follows:

- A temporary crossover needs to be constructed on the motorway to allow motorists to travel in both directions on one carriageway. This will allow work to be carried out safely on the other carriageway. This work has been approved by the Department of the Environment Climate Change and Water (DECCW) to be carried out at night because it requires full lane closures. The use of crossovers and contraflow traffic will shorten the duration of night work required to install safety traffic barriers.

Weather permitting, this work will take place on the dates shown over the page. Hours of work are from 8 pm until 5.30 am. Machinery and equipment used will include lights, generator, saw cutting machine, excavator, tipper trucks, water tankers, road sweeper, roller, asphalt paving machine, core drill, and delivery trucks.

You may experience increased noise levels as a result of this work. The project team will take several measures to keep this to a minimum, including:

- using non-tonal reversing alarms;
- shrouding all stationery equipment; and
- completing saw-cutting before midnight, except if it is unsafe to leave the pavement in the state it is in at that time.

The information/complaints line 1800 196 266 will be attended during the day and night during construction. Complaints received via the 1800 number will be responded to within two hours and investigation of the complaint will proceed at the earliest opportunity.

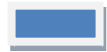

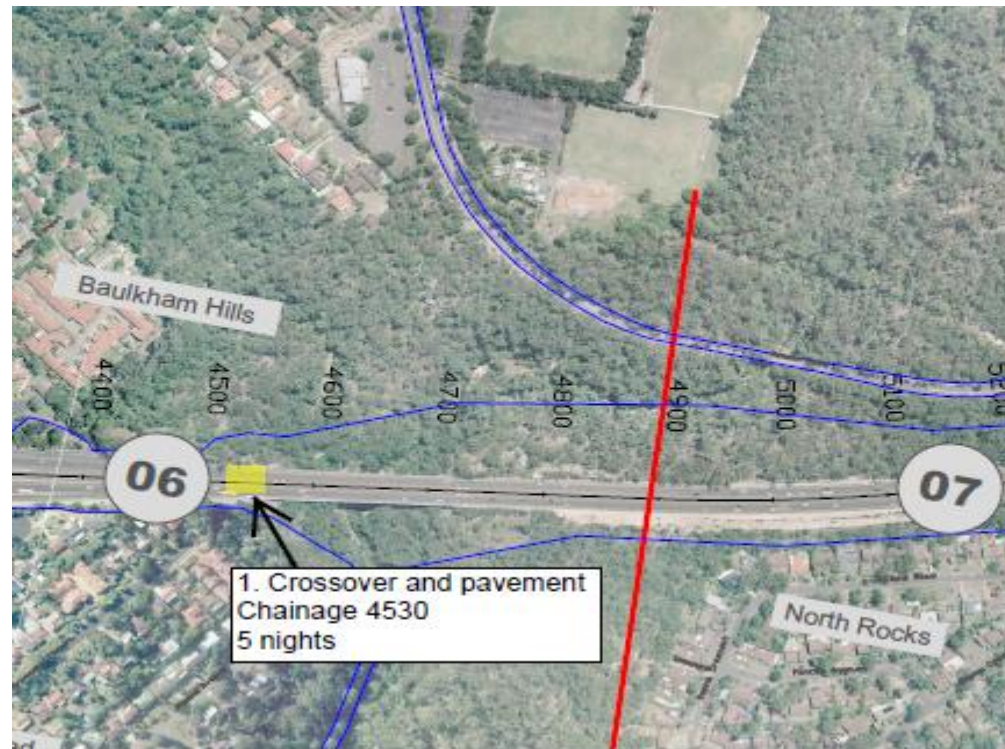
