

# Beecroft Road bus ramp removal

**Hills M2**



Delays are expected on the Hills M2 Motorway while removal of the Beecroft Road bus ramp is completed.

Work to dismantle and remove the bus ramp will be undertaken from **8pm Fridays to 5am Mondays** over three consecutive weekends, starting 10 February, weather permitting. Further work will take place on the weekends of 17–20 February and 24–27 February with a contingency weekend planned for 2–5 March, if required.

Removing the bus ramp will allow the construction of an additional lane in both directions on the motorway in this area. On completion of the upgrade, the speed limit will be reinstated to 100km/h between Lane Cove and Windsor roads, including the Norfolk Tunnel.

During this time, a contra flow traffic arrangement will be in place on the opposite carriageway to where the work is being undertaken allowing **one lane to remain open in both directions**.

Other motorway upgrade work will be ongoing during these periods, including work at Devlins Creek Bridge, Norfolk Tunnel and west of the Terrys Creek Bridge.

The following on and off ramp closures will be implemented:

- Westbound Beecroft Road off-ramp will be closed from **8pm Friday 10 February to 5am Monday 13 February only**.
- Citybound Pennant Hills Road and Beecroft Road on-ramps will be closed, as required, between **8am and 7pm Saturdays and Sundays** on all three weekends.
- Westbound Herring Road and Lane Cove Road on-ramps will be closed, as required, between **8am and 7pm Saturdays and Sundays** on all three weekends.

Please drive with care, follow the road signs and drive to the 40km/h roadwork speed limit. Consider using alternative routes such as Epping Road and Carlingford Road.
