



Hills M2 Upgrade work October to December 2011

The Hills M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. Work is expected to be completed in early 2013.

Work scheduled from October to December 2011 includes:

- Commence tunnel widening work requiring ongoing weekend closures.
- Complete vegetation clearing.
- Ongoing earthworks, drainage and widening work along the motorway.
- Commence construction of new westbound pavement between Pennant Hills Road and Windsor Road.
- Ongoing bridge works at:
 - Windsor Road Bridge
 - Darling Mills Creek Bridge
 - Barclay Road Bridge
 - Yale Close Bridge
 - Murray Farm Road Bridge
 - Devlins Creek Bridge
 - Beecroft Road Bridge
 - Terrys Creek Bridge
 - Christie Road Bridge
 - Khartoum Road Bridge
- Ongoing installation of new permanent noise walls.
- Commence removal of some temporary noise walls.
- Night work may be required for:
 - Tunnel rock bolting and excavation
 - Bridgework including beam installation
 - Drainage and culvert installation
 - Removal of temporary walls
 - Pavement repairs and strengthening

Some of this work involves changes to traffic conditions on the motorway, local roads and bridges. The Hills M2 Upgrade team appreciates your patience and apologises for any inconvenience caused.
