Re: Night work to lengthen the temporary noise wall near Kerry Avenue, Epping, commencing 30 June

The Hills M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and will deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. We aim to provide an efficient and integrated transport for the community of Sydney's North-West. Major work started in January 2011 and is expected to take around two years to complete.

This night work involves extending the temporary noise wall 60m to the west of the existing temporary noise wall near Kerry Avenue on the westbound carriageway of the motorway.

What is happening with the noise wall at this location?

1. The temporary noise wall will be extended 60m to the west of the existing temporary noise wall. Please note that the temporary noise wall will not be located in the same position as the permanent noise wall.
2. Once the temporary noise wall is complete, the corresponding existing noise wall will be removed.
3. The new permanent noise wall will be constructed around August 2011. The new permanent noise wall will be made of similar materials and will be 6m high.

Why can't the new permanent noise wall be constructed now?

The new permanent noise wall at this location cannot be built until the excavation required for widening work is completed.

Some of this work requires lane closures at night due to the high volume of traffic during daytime peak periods. Approved hours of night works are from 8pm to 5am. Night work will take place on the dates shown over the page.

The following equipment will be used:

- Light vehicles
- Small tools and generators
- Lights

You may experience increased noise levels during this work. We will take measures to keep this to a minimum, including:

- Using non-tonal reversing alarms, which make a "quacking" sound instead of a "beeping" sound.
- Shrouding all stationary equipment and using hoarding where possible.
