



Hills M2 Upgrade work April to June 2011

The Hills M2 upgrade will widen the existing motorway between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. It is expected to take approximately two years to complete the upgrade.

Work scheduled from April to June 2011 includes:

- Ongoing vegetation clearing, earthworks, drainage, pavement and widening work along the motorway.
- Ongoing bridge work at:
 - Windsor Road Bridge, Baulkham Hills
 - Darling Mills Creek Bridge, Baulkham Hills
 - Barclay Road Bridge, North Rocks
 - Devlins Creek Bridge, Beecroft
 - Murray Farm Road Bridge, Beecroft
 - Beecroft Road Bridge, Cheltenham
 - Terrys Creek Bridge, Marsfield
 - Christie Road Bridge, Macquarie Park
- Ongoing relocation of noise walls.
- Start of tunnel widening work in the eastbound portal.
- Set up of compounds for bridge and tunnel work.
- Removal of the toll plaza canopy.
- Night works are scheduled for:
 - Vegetation clearing
 - Bridgeworks
 - Set up of traffic management
 - Noise wall relocations
 - Sign relocations

Outside of weekday peak periods, expect changes to traffic, particularly at night. Please drive carefully and follow the signs.

Standard construction hours are from Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm.
