

## M2 Upgrade investigative works

As a part of the concept design for the proposed M2 Upgrade, investigative works have commenced to obtain important data about ground conditions and existing services in the motorway corridor and surrounding areas.

**The planned works will be completed by 26 February 2010**, and will include geotechnical and services investigations, with some cut sampling at existing cut sites along the M2.

Local residents have been advised about the works via letterbox drops.

Service works will be undertaken on weekdays between 7am and 6pm. These works will not impact traffic operations, nor will they result in any increase in ambient noise for local residents.

Cut sampling works will involve the use of backhoes with hydraulic hammers and will be undertaken week nights between 8pm and 5am, to minimise motorway traffic impacts.

Every effort will be made to minimise noisy works, however this activity will generate some noise. To limit the noise disturbance to local residents, such works would occur from 8pm to 12 midnight.

During this time, affected areas of the motorway could be subject to reduced speeds and reduced capacity to ensure the safety of road users and the works engineers. Some delays may be experienced, so motorists are asked to take extra care and observe signage on the motorway which will provide advance notice of any lane closures or changed traffic conditions.
