Reminder: Changed traffic conditions on Murray Farm Road Bridge, Beecroft

The Hills M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and will deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. The project aims to provide efficient and integrated transport for the community of Sydney's North-West. Major work started in January 2011 and is expected to take approximately two years to complete.

As part of the upgrade, Murray Farm Road Bridge (also known as Kirkham Street Bridge) will be lengthened by approximately 8 metres on the northern side. This work will take approximately 20 months to complete.

To facilitate the bridge work, traffic across the bridge will be reduced to one lane from the week commencing 18 April until the bridge work is complete. Traffic signals will alternate the flow of traffic. Motorists can expect delays, particularly in peak periods. Signs will be in place to notify motorists of the changed conditions. Pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained.

Please drive carefully and follow the signs. Thank you for your patience.

The community complaints and information line 1800 196 266 will be attended day and night during construction. Complaints will be responded to within two hours and investigation of the complaint will proceed at the earliest opportunity.
