Re: Set up of the Norfolk Tunnel compound

The Hills M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway generally between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and will deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. The project aims to provide efficient and integrated transport for the community of Sydney's North-West.

Major work started in January 2011 and is expected to take around two years to complete. Part of this work will require widening of the Norfolk Tunnel. A construction compound is required for this work.

Work to set up the tunnel construction compound will start in the week beginning 18 April. The compound will be located between Sutherland Road and Constance Close north of the motorway, Cheltenham. At this stage, access to the compound will be from the motorway, please refer to the map shown over.

The compound will be used for the duration of the project and may be in use 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. The compound will include containers to store equipment and materials, work sheds and site amenities.

Work to set up the compound will take about eight weeks to complete and will be undertaken during standard construction hours, Monday to Friday from 7am to 6pm and Saturday from 8am to 1pm. If night work is required to set up the compound, a separate notification will be provided to potentially affected residents with dates and details at least seven days prior to start of these works.

Work to set up the compound will include:

- Erecting safety fences and noise wall gates.
- Installation of sediment controls.
- Clearing of work area and earthworks.
- Excavation to establish access on and off the M2.
- Installation of services including a water treatment plant and lighting.
- Setting up of temporary office buildings.

Clearing of vegetation at the site will be minimised by retaining mature trees wherever possible.

The community information line 1800 196 266 will be attended day and night during construction. Complaints received will be responded to within two hours and investigation of the complaint will proceed at the earliest opportunity.
