PLEASE NOTE NIGHT WORK DATE CHANGES

Re: Night work to deliver and install concrete beams at Devlins Creek Bridge Beecroft, starting 28 February 2012

The Hills M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and will deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. The project aims to provide efficient and integrated transport for the community of Sydney's North-West. Major work started in January 2011 and is expected to be completed in early 2013.

As part of the Devlins Creek Bridge widening, concrete beams will be delivered and installed in the motorway median. This work will be undertaken at night from 8pm to 5am when traffic volumes are lower. The work will be carried out on the dates shown over the page, weather permitting.

Work activities

Machinery and equipment used will include dual 80 tonne cranes, semi trailers, lighting towers and hand tools. You may experience increased noise levels as a result of the work. The project team will take measures to keep this to a minimum, including:

- Using non-tonal reversing alarms, which make a "quacking" sound instead of a "beeping" sound.
- Shrouding stationary equipment and using hoarding where possible.

Traffic arrangements

The westbound carriageway of the motorway west of Murray Farm Road will be temporary closed during the work. Westbound traffic will be diverted to the citybound carriageway under a contra flow arrangement. Speed limits in the contra flow area will be reduced to 40 kph. Please follow the signs and drive with care.

The community complaints and information line 1800 196 266 (select option 2) will be attended 24 hours per day, 7 days per week during construction. Complaints will be responded to within two hours and investigation of the complaint will proceed at the earliest opportunity.

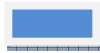

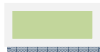
