PLEASE NOTE: NIGHT WORK DATE CHANGES

Re: Night work to pour the new deck of the Devlins Creek Bridge, Beecroft commencing 24 February

Significant progress has been made on the Hills M2 Upgrade since work started in January 2011. The project will reduce congestion and travel times during the busy morning and afternoon periods and improve access on the motorway. The upgrade will be completed in the first half of 2013.

Concrete will be poured along the westbound carriageway of the motorway to join the existing Devlins Creek Bridge to the newly widened bridge deck. This work will be undertaken at night when traffic volumes on the motorway are lower. Please see the dates of night work and location over the page.

Work Activities

Machinery and equipment needed for this work includes a crane, concrete trucks, concrete vibrators, lighting towers, light vehicles and hand tools. You may experience increased noise levels as a result of this work. We will take measures to keep this to a minimum, including using non-tonal reversing alarms, which make a “quacking” sound instead of a “beeping” sound.

Traffic changes

From **8pm Friday to 5am Monday** on the dates shown over the page, the westbound carriageway of the motorway will be closed to pour the new concrete and allow it to cure. Traffic will be diverted to the eastbound carriageway under a contra flow arrangement and the speed limit will be reduced to 40km/h. At least one lane will remain open in each direction at all times.

To reduce the impacts on motorists and residents this work will be carried out in conjunction with the Beecroft Road bus ramp demolition. Delays to citybound and westbound traffic are expected, particularly during the middle of the day on Saturdays and Sundays due to reduced lanes and speed limits. Please follow the signs and drive with care. Motorists are advised to consider alternative routes. Please check www.livetraffic.com for up to date traffic information.

The community complaints and information line 1800 196 266 (select option 2) will be attended day and night during construction. Complaints received will be responded to within two hours and investigation of the complaint will proceed at the earliest opportunity.
