Re: Night work to relocate the noise wall on Terrys Creek Bridge commencing 16 January 2012

Significant progress has been made on the Hills M2 Upgrade since major work started in January 2011. The project will reduce congestion and travel times during the busy morning and afternoon periods and improve access to the motorway. The upgrade will be completed in the first half of 2013.

A temporary noise wall extending approximately 190m will be constructed on the citybound carriageway of the motorway over Terrys Creek Bridge, North Epping. Concrete traffic barriers will be installed on 16 January 2012 before the temporary noise wall work commences on 19 January 2012, see dates over the page.

What is happening with the noise wall at this location?

1. A new temporary noise wall will be constructed across Terrys Creek Bridge on the citybound carriageway of the motorway. The temporary noise wall will be located on the motorway side of the existing noise wall. The temporary noise wall will be approximately 3.3m high and made from timber.
2. After the temporary noise wall is built, the existing noise wall will be removed to allow for Terrys Creek Bridge widening work to take place.
3. The new permanent noise wall at this location will be constructed in early March 2012, will be made of similar materials to the existing noise wall and will be between 4.8m and 3.2m in height. The height of the new noise wall will be 4.8m near the residential area of Woodvale Avenue, and will decrease to 3.6m towards the eastern end of the bridge.

Why can't the new permanent noise wall be constructed now?

The new permanent noise wall at this location cannot be built until deck work on the Terrys Creek Bridge is complete.

Work Activities

Machinery and equipment required for this work includes: light vehicles, small tools, generators and lights. You may experience increased noise levels during this work. We will take measures to keep this to a minimum, including:

- Using non-tonal reversing alarms, which make a “quacking” sound instead of a “beeping” sound.
- Shrouding all stationary equipment and using hoarding where possible.
