Re: Night work east of the Norfolk Tunnel - utility investigations

The Hills M2 Upgrade will widen the existing motorway between Windsor Road, Baulkham Hills and Lane Cove Road, North Ryde and will deliver four new ramps to improve access to the motorway. We aim to provide efficient and integrated transport for the community of Sydney's North-West. Major work started in January 2011 and is expected to take around two years to complete.

As part of the upgrade, the Norfolk Tunnel will be widened to provide three lanes and a breakdown lane in each tunnel tube. To facilitate this work, utility investigations will be undertaken on the eastbound lanes of the motorway east of the tunnel.

This work involves drilling through the road surface on the eastbound lanes to locate power and telecommunication services. A vacuum truck will then remove the spoil.

Night time utility investigations will be carried out between the approved hours of work of 8pm to 5am. However, core drilling will be completed by midnight. This work is scheduled to take place on the dates shown over the page.

Machinery and equipment used will include core drills, vacuum trucks, small power tools and lighting towers. You may experience increased noise levels as a result of this work. The project team will take measures to keep this to a minimum, including:

- Completing core drilling by midnight.
- Using non-tonal reversing alarms, which make a "quacking" sound instead of a "beeping" sound.
- Shrouding all stationary equipment and using hoarding where possible.

This work requires a full closure of the eastbound tunnel tube at night due to the high volume of traffic during daytime peak periods. Eastbound traffic will be diverted to the westbound tube which will operate with one lane in each direction.

The community complaints and information line 1800 196 266 will be attended day and night during construction. Complaints received will be responded to within two hours and we will investigate the complaint as soon as possible.
